PAST A 'CURSE'

BABY-SCANDAL mum Judith Kilshaw has split from her third husband — after he branded their marriage “cursed” by her past.

Stephen Sillett told pals he could no longer handle the abuse they received every time they went out.

The final straw came when he was involved in a fight after the couple were taunted by boozed-up locals in a pub.

Judith, 58, became a hate figure 11 years ago after she and her then-husband, solicitor Alan Kilshaw, paid £8,200 to adopt twin baby girls advertised for sale on the internet. But the High Court ruled they should return to the US.

Judith wed Stephen, 45, in 2009. He left after the incident in Wrexham, telling pals her past was a “curse”. *l.veevers@the-sun.co.uk*
